



Brave the Rain. Save the Forest.



The area named Tarkine, or Takayna is one of the wettest places in the Southern Hemisphere and is over 450,000 hectares in size. It is here that you will find majestic trees that have been growing for over 500 years, where species of tree ferns from the Gondwana age still thrive, and where the world's largest crayfish, growing up to a metre long and weighing 6 kilograms, calls home. This was the last refuge of the Tasmanian Tiger and it is the main habit of the world's largest marsupial carnivore, the iconic Tasmanian Devil. As you walk the dunes you will find remnants of campsites of the Takayna people, their spirits still can be felt in the rugged majestic beauty of this place. Now imagine the scream of the chainsaw, the growl of the dozer as loggers, and the miners taking control of the forest. This area is now subject to 58 mineral leases and numerous logging coups – all within a National Park. The clear-felling of this virgin rainforest will spell the end of a number of species, including the critically endangered Swift parrot and the endangered Masked Owl. The creation of massive open-cut mines along with their tailings dams will spell the end to the river life that is abundant in this area. The water quality will be destroyed for all time. This simply cannot be allowed to happen. In order to stop the destruction, we will be partnering with the Save The Tarkine Foundation.
